

What's the Cheetah?

A freeride sail that's fast, powerful, and easy to handle—without cams.

Who's it for?

Sailors who want speed and control with simple rigging. Forgiving for intermediates, exciting for experts.

What makes it different?

The drive and stability of a cambered sail, minus the cams.

What we focused on:

- Balanced and light
- · Speed at both ends of the wind spectrum.
- · A build quality that lasts for years

Key details:

- · Low, forward center of effort balances pull
- · Scrim reinforcements stay light, even wet
- · Less downhaul gives a fuller leading edge and more low-end

Why you'll like it:

You can own fewer sails—the Cheetah has a huge wind range. It's built with scrim, Dyneema X-Ply, and RBS epoxy battens. The calibrated downhaul marks take the guesswork out of rigging. Every Cheetah is pre-rigged in my factory before it ships.

Bottom line:

The Cheetah is fun to sail, easy to rig, and built to last.
